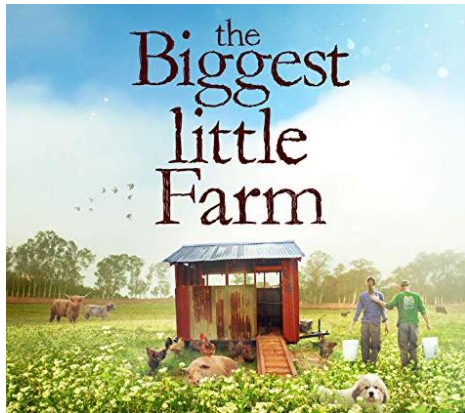


The Earth is not Dying
